--'06 Super Cruise Car Show event. Feb. 11-12, 2006 at the Kern County Fairgrounds in conjunction with the Central Valley Sportsman & RV Show. Practically the entire meeting was again devoted to organizing this event. Here's a recap. **Event t-shirts**—the shirts were not quite ready to have at the January meeting but are in the process of being done. We will have t-shirts (\$15) available and these prices are for sizes S-XL. XXL and XXXL cost \$2 more per item. Special thanks to the 2006 Super Cruise Event Sponsors: Stokers Car Club, Zingo's Café, B.E.M.R. and Fabrications by Addington. The event Co-Sponsors are San Joaquin Valley Dust Control Service and Nikkel Iron Works. **Car Parking/Gate Control**—Lloyd Prather/Studebaker Club volunteered once again to help out with this task. Sherry Aal got the BHS ROTC to also come help. They will provide us with ten (10) helpers each day to aid in parking. **Food**—Richard Lopez stated that Food Land will be there and do the food and donate 50% of proceeds back to us for the Society. **Awards/Event Donations**—All Merchant Award plaque sponsors needed to be brought to the January meeting from any clubs. Peg McElroy/Studebaker Drivers Club has started working on them. We put the order in with John Fleming/Precision Trophies for the event dash plaques. Mike Hatcher/Central Valley Sportsman & RV Shows is donating the "Rudy Gallups Memorial Trophy". **Registration/Car Show Entries**—BCCC Spokespersons Bette Addington & Richard Lopez will be handling this task and Kay Behling/Camaro Club volunteered to also help. **Entertainment**—Thanks again to Mike Hatcher, we will have a DJ, Gary Murphy, that will be up on the Budweiser Pavilion stage playing '50s music and we also will have the ROTC performing their routines and a local band, plus on Sunday, Grant Schofield will perform soon after 12pm and then a swing dancers group will do a routine. **Swap Meet**—Vintage Ltd. was asked to handle this portion also after they decided not to handle the food and they again declined, and no one at the January meeting wanted to take this on so we won't be having a Swap Meet. **Poker Walks**—It was decided that we would conduct a Poker Walk each day, one on Saturday and one on Sunday.
