#### BCCC Sanctioning draft

We are proposing a sanction process whereby The Bakersfield Car Club Council (BCCC) could sanction various car club events that fit the criteria to be sanctioned by the BCCC. We feel this will not only help a club with their event to have their event sanctioned by the BCCC, but it will also establish credibility for both the BCCC and that club.

Please look the following items over and bring your comments to the next BCCC meeting on August 13.

Criteria for having an event sanctioned by The Bakersfield Car Club Council:

- Event must not be held on a date that is already taken by an established local car event.
  - Event must have portion of proceeds going to a charity of the club's choice.
  - Event must report amount of proceeds given to that particular charity after event has taken place. This report will be first announced at a BCCC meeting and then published in the following BCCC newsletter after that meeting.
  - Once event is accepted as a "sanctioned BCCC event", this will be published on that event's registration flyer.

What The Bakersfield Car Club Council will do for a certified sanctioned event:

- Publish the event on the BCCC Calendar of Events (up to a year in advance). This BCCC Calendar of Event goes out to many state car calendar publications who will, in turn, publicize event in their publication.
- Make copies of event flyer and publish in BCCC newsletter a month before event takes place to help publicize it.
- Send event info to The Bakersfield Californian to have them publish event in Saturday's "AutoMart" to help club advertise event.

The Bakersfield Car Club Council was established in 1988 by Ken Kisor and Chris Addington in order to bring local car/truck clubs together to communicate with one another as well as schedule their events so that they were not taking place on the same day, and also to build commerodity amongst clubs where they would support each other's events.
