

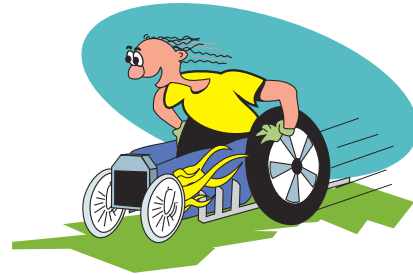

Besides the car show that day at Beach Park, there will be a craft show, raffle and hot dogs and drinks. Cost to enter is \$30. There will also be a Poker Run at the cost of \$5 to enter. Event benefits Make a Wish and last year they were able to raise \$4800 to go to this charity. Their event also features a '50s dance that evening at the Moose Lodge with a steak dinner. --**Mike Hatcher/Central Valley Sportsmen Boat & RV Show.** **Mike** again was back this month to answer any questions we might have concerning our upcoming BCCC "Super Cruise" Car Show at his event on Sat., Feb. 12th. He asked that we give him an agenda of our day's events so he can have the show announcer announce our event over the fairgrounds PA system. He said they would be setting up out at the fairgrounds starting the week before the Feb. 12th weekend and if we needed to come by to use Gate 26, except for the Saturday of our event when we use Gate 28. He said he could supply us with VIP passes for our sponsor plaque people to allow them to get into the event that day to make their pick and needed to know how many we needed. We thanked **Mike** for allowing us to have this event and hoped we could bring in enough money for our yearly donation to the Society for Disabled Children of Kern County.

--**BCCC "Super Cruise" Car Show.** We discussed and decided at the January BCCC meeting to proceed with having the BCCC "Super Cruise" Car Show on Sat., Feb. 12th, at the Kern County Fairgrounds in conjunction with the 28th annual Central Valley Sportsmen Boat & RV Show. Event flyers were passed out and are also available on our website to download. On the back of the flyer you can either enter the car show for \$20 or make a donation to be a sponsor for \$50. With such a short time between now and when the event takes place, it was stressed that we really need all BCCC clubs to come together to make this event a success for the Society for Disabled Children. This event will take the place of our annual BCCC Super Cruise for this year. At the January BCCC meeting, challenges were put out to all other clubs to help get this event off the ground. **Old Friends of Bakersfield** challenged all BCCC clubs to meet or beat

- There will be no classes. All cars will be on display and clubs may park together. Those who purchase sponsor plaques will come out and make their pick and those picked will be presented with a plaque from the sponsor that selects your vehicle. All sponsor plaques must be ordered and paid for ahead of time (absolute deadline for sponsor plaques is Tues., Feb. 8th.) We currently have 52 sponsor plaques and are shooting for 60. **Peg McElroy/Charlotte's Creations** and member of **Studebaker Driver's Club** and **Old Friends** is doing the plaques for us and with this short of notice, she deserves a serious "atta girl!"
