Note: This was a special meeting held on Thurs., Feb. 9, at the Society for Disabled Children after the goodie bag stuffing for the 2006 Super Cruise Car Show which took the place of our regularly scheduled February Council meeting.

--**Van Horn School**. Members/parents of Van Horn School came to the goodie bag stuffing to see how it was done as the upcoming March 18th Car Show will be their first venture of putting on this kind of event.

Goodie Bag Stuffing: This night kicked off with the goodie bag stuffing starting at 6:30pm. A huge crew from **Old Friends of Bakersfield** arrived ready to stuff at 6pm. Special thanks to **OFOB** for all the help as we were able to stuff the 200 bags in less than 20 minutes—close to a record!! Besides **OFOB**, members from **OFCC** and a few other clubs came early to help and it was a great team effort to kick-start the Super Cruise event. Thanks to **Richard Lopez/El Caminos** for supplying the bags to stuff and to all the individuals who brought goodies to put in the bags and event flyers.

Event Review/Wrap-Up:

--There were no events to give recap on at this meeting.

Upcoming Events:

--'06 Super Cruise Car Show event. Feb. 11-12, 2006 at the Kern County Fairgrounds in conjunction with the Central Valley Sportsman & RV Show. This meeting was specially set up to go over any last-minute items to help the event run that much more smoothly. We had (74) pre-registered car entrants at the time of this meeting. Unfortunately this year the count was down on the Merchant Plaques as we had only about (40) at the time of the meeting but several clubs and individuals stepped up at this meeting and sponsored a Merchant Plaque so that helped. All the committees seemed to be handled in what their specific tasks were. The only major problem we faced was the Poker Walk and **Mike Horton/Golden Empire Mustangs** had this area pretty much given to him to handle by himself since **Roy Romagno/Model T Club** suddenly got ill and was pretty sure he would not be able to be at the event to help **Mike**. **Don Crook/Chevilles & El Caminos** stepped up and said he would help **Mike** and several others said they would also. We were on our way!!

--BCCC Website/Webmaster. The only other item we really discussed was whether or not to accept and pay **John Halstead/Bakersfield Camaro Club** for continuing on to keep our BCCC website maintained and going for us. **John** quoted us \$11.95/month or \$143 per year plus domain registration is \$10 per year and he would only charge us \$20 per month to do updates (10 items each month) for a total of \$393 for the year. Motion was made to accept this quote from **John** and pay the yearly fee of \$393 and vote was taken and it was approved. A couple of months ago we had asked at the Council meeting if
